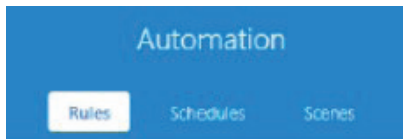
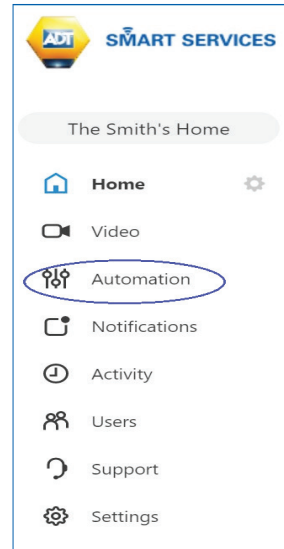
VIEWING ALL RULES & SCHEDULES

Click on [Rules](#) to see all the current rules, and click [Schedules](#) to see all the current schedules on the menu.

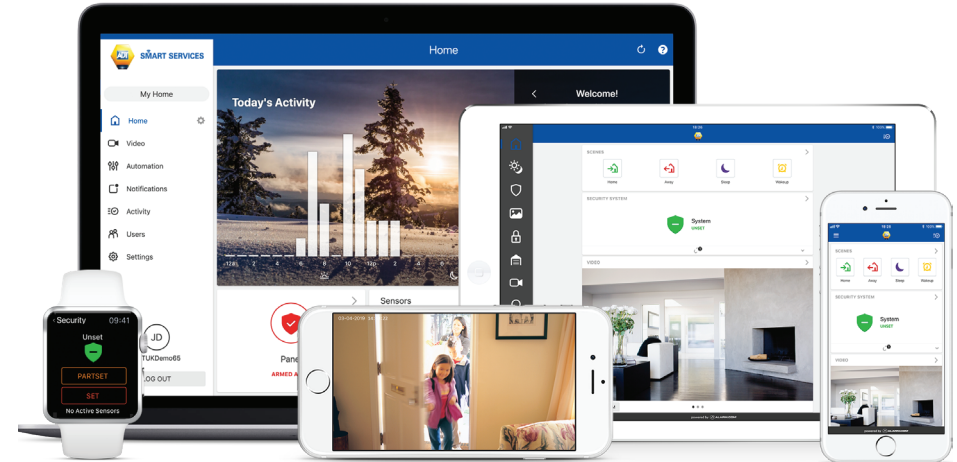

Smart Plugs -Event Rules

The inclusion of ADT's smart plugs in your home security system are an easy and convenient way to enhance security.

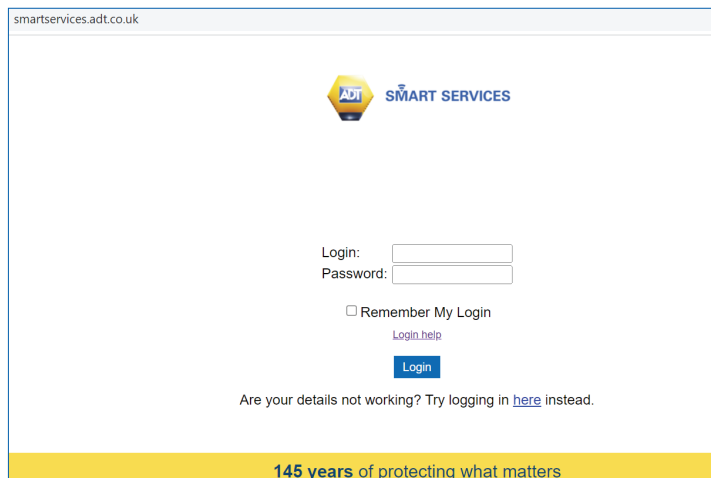
However it's the ability to set up rules and schedules with other ADT devices in your home that really makes your home security smart.

Once your smart plugs are linked to your security system there are a number of options you can use:

Getting started with Rules and Schedules is simple and can be done from the ADT *Smart Services* web portal.

1 VISIT THE SMART SERVICES PORTAL

Go to at www.smartservices.co.uk and log in, these will be the same login details you will use for the ADT Smart Services Mobile app



2 EXAMPLES OF RULES

Here are some examples of the rules you can use to enhance your security system.

Turn lights / power socket on when somebody walks past a motion detector or opens a door

Turn lights / power socket on when a video device detects movement

Turn lights / power socket off to save power when you leave home or set the alarm

Turn lights / power socket on a random times when out to simulate occupancy

Turn Lights / power socket on or off based on your location (Geo Fence)

Schedule the Smart plug to turn on or off at set times

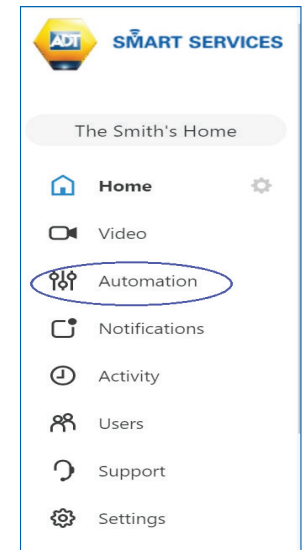
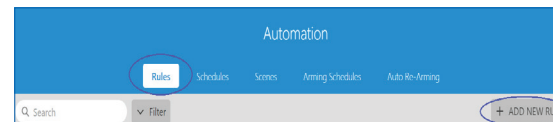
3 HOW TO SET UP A NEW RULE

Once you have logged into the Smart Services web portal you will see the menu options like those displayed on the left.

Click on the option 'Automation'

Here you will see a page displaying your current rules and schedules.

Click **Rules** and then **+ Add New Rule** as shown below.



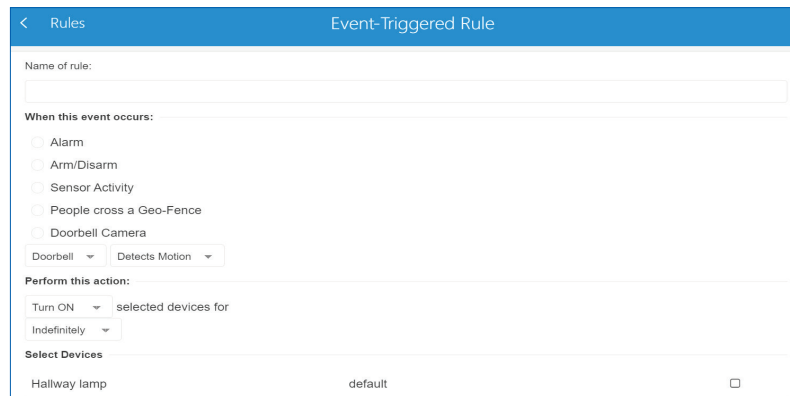
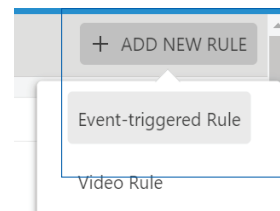
Smart Plugs -Event Rules

4 EVENT RULE

An event-triggered rule can be programmed to occur in the event of an alarm, when you arm or disarm the system, when any of the security sensors on your system such as movement detectors or door contacts are active or inactive or when people cross a Geo-fence (see section below on Geo-Fence for more information).

Select [Event-triggering Rule](#) as show.

Give your rule a name so that you can easily identify it.



You will then need to tick the option(s) for when you would like the event to occur.

[Alarm events can be all alarms or specific sensors. When you select alarm you will be presented with further options.](#)

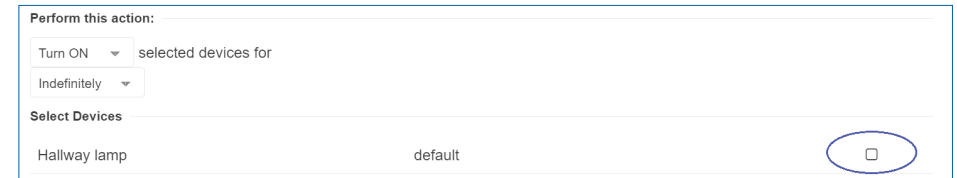
[An event can be programmed to occur when the system is armed stay or away or when the system is disarmed.](#)

[An event can be programmed for any sensor activity.](#)

[An event can occur if a Geo-Fence is crossed.](#)

5 ACTIONS TAKEN & TIME FRAME

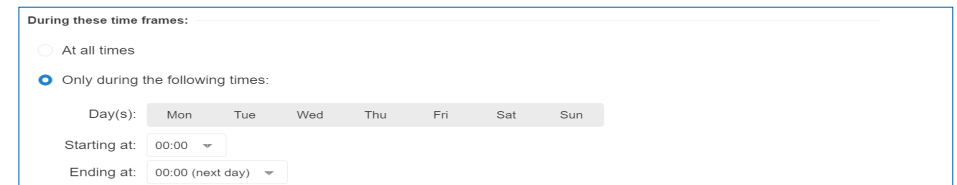
Once you have selected when the event occurs you next have to program what happens.



The options above allow you to turn ON or OFF the selected device with a time frame ranging from 15seconds to 24hrs, or indefinitely.

You then need to select the device you want to control, a list of all your smart devices will be shown, ensure that you tick the device you wish to control using the box as shown above.

Lastly you must set how when you want the rule to run. The following options can be selected, [All Times](#) or on [Set Days/Times](#).



6 SAVE

Once you completed the rule and set all the options you require as detailed above ensure that you save the rule by hitting the [Save](#) button.



Your rule will now be active and will appear in the list of rules in the [Automation](#) section of the portal.

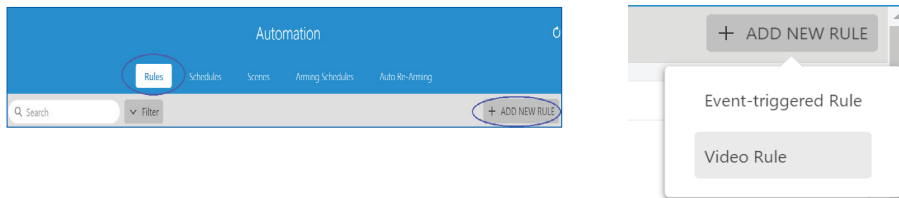
Smart Plugs- Video Rules

1 VIDEO RULE

A video rule can be configured to record video when activity is detected inside a ground zone or when a tripwire is crossed. Smart video alerts will notify you only about objects (people, vehicles or animals) that you mark as important.

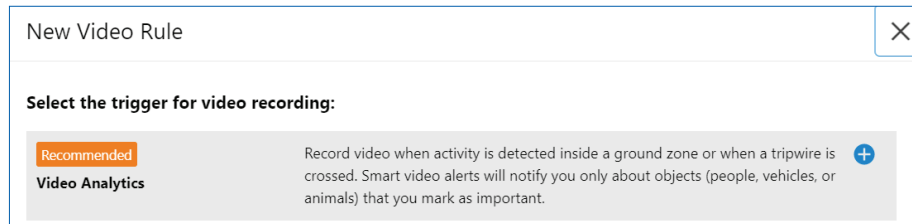
Ensure you are logged into the ADT Smart Services App as shown in step 1 of Event Rules (page 2).

Click on the option **Automation** on the main menu,
Click **Rules** and then **+ Add New Rule**,
and then Select **Video Rule** as shown below.



2 VIDEO ANALYTICS

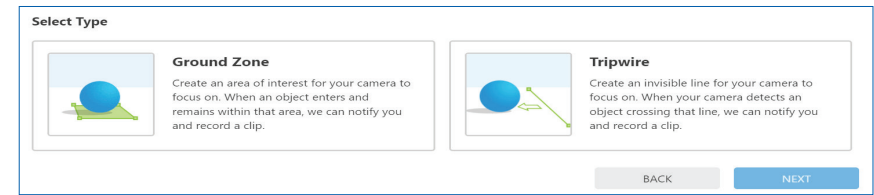
It is recommended to select a **Video Analytics** rule from the video rule options.



3 SELECT THE CAMERA

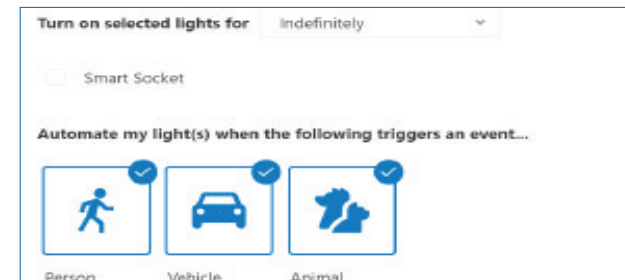
If you have multiple ADT smart cameras at your property you will see these listed with the names you have already given them e.g. Hallway camera, Livingroom cam, Garden cam etc...

You must select camera you wish to set the rule for and then select the options either creating a **Ground Zone** area or a virtual **Tripwire**. Select an option click next and set up the areas you want to trigger the recording to your preferences.



4 VIDEO ANALYTICS

Our smart video analytics, enable you to select and customise what you want the record, capture and be notified about. You can use these to select what you want to trigger the smart plugs. As shown below:



5 SAVE

Once you completed the rule click the **Save** button.
